- ♦ Design a poster related to anti-bullying or cyberbullying prevention (i.e. bullying, cyberbullying, the role of bystanders, or dealing with bullying)
- ♦ Be creative! Use words, draw pictures, make it colorful! Be You!
- ♦ The contest will run from Sept. 1st-Sept 23th. Submissions must be received no later than 4 p.m. Thursday Sept 23, 2021
- ♦ Posters must be designed on a 8.5"x11" piece of paper (standard printer size).
- ♦ Completed registration form and photo release form must be submitted with poster submission.
- ♦ Submit posters to 72fss.fsy.schoolliaison@us.af.mil or drop off at A&FRC (Bldg. 6001)
- ♦ Finalist will be posted on Tinker AFB School Liaison, Tinker Airman & Family Readiness Center– A&FRC and Tinker AFB Exceptional Family Support Group... Facebook pages for voting between Sept 24th and Noon Sept 27
- ♦ Winners will be notified by call/text &/or email and posted on Facebook
- ♦ Winning posters will be displayed at the Tinker Youth Center, Library, Exchange, various other locations and schools where allowed
